

Question No. **Question Type (Suggested)** **Chapters and Explanation**

Q1: MCQs	Total of about 17 questions	Specified number from each chapter: for example, 2 questions each from Chapters 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 11; 1 question each from Chapters 4, 6, 7, 9, 10.
Q2: Short Questions	Short questions (e.g., choice out of 8)	More short questions expected from some chapters like Chapters 1, 2, 3.
Q3: Short Questions	The second part of short questions should focus on some chapters like Chapters 5, 6, 7, 8.	
Q4: Short Questions	The third part of short questions will include the remaining important chapters like Chapters 9, 10, 11.	
Q5–Q9: Long Questions	Students will be given five questions, out of which three will have to be solved. For example: • Question 5 → Chapter 2 (Part A) and Chapter 3 (Part B) • Question 6 → Chapter 4 (A) and Chapter 8 (B) • Question 7 → Chapter 5 (A) and Chapter 7 (B) • Question 8 → Chapter 6 (A) and Chapter 11 (B) • Question 9 → Chapter 9 (A) and Chapter 10 (B).
